

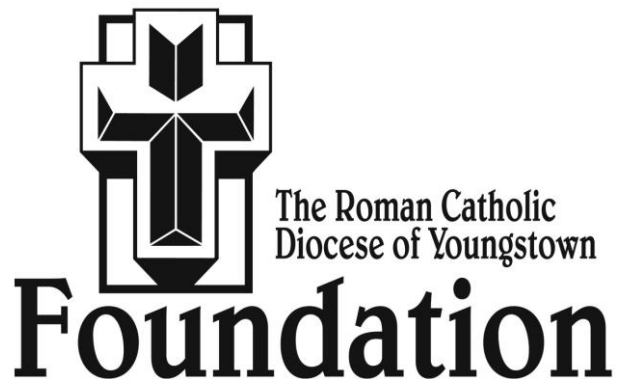

In an effort to encourage philanthropy, practitioners need simply ask clients making an estate plan the question, **“Do you have charitable inclinations you wish to include?”** This simple question opens the mind and heart to the realization that one can give something back and make an impact in this world.

The Roman Catholic Diocese of Youngstown Foundation offers donors the opportunity to faithfully promote the saving work of our Lord Jesus beyond their own lifetime. By establishing an endowment fund (Donor Designated Fund) or contributing to an existing endowment fund, Catholics can support their favorite Catholic causes in perpetuity. An endowment fund is a fund comprised of gifts which, when invested, provide interest income in support of a designated purpose ... forever! Typically only the interest earned on the fund is used for the purpose stated in the fund agreement and the asset base remains untouched. The asset base of the fund grows through sound investment and additional gifts.

Practitioners are encouraged to promote endowed gifts in the Diocese of Youngstown Foundation when talking with clients having a desire to support the charities listed in this Manual

To establish a Donor Designated Fund an individual or family makes a **minimum gift of \$10,000**. The Foundation will accept “outright / current gifts” or “future interest / gifts” (e.g. bequests, Charitable Remainder Trusts, Gift Annuities and etc.). The Fund is named by the creator and will distribute income annually to the favorite Catholic cause(s) within the Diocese of Youngstown as designated by the creator

Contributions are always welcome in support of Endowment Funds already established in the Foundation. Funds supporting Catholic Education, Catholic Charities and others support popular causes in our diocese. Additional examples include: The Bishop James W. Malone Catholic Education Fund, The Bishop Benedict C. Franzetta Priesthood Formation Fund, and the Reverend Philip P. Conley Lay Ministry Fund. Gifts in any amount are welcome to established Endowment Funds.

Directory Overview

INTRODUCTION

This directory is intended to assist those involved in financial and estate planning practices when helping clients make charitable gifts.

Clients often have charitable intentions, but sometimes may need assistance articulating them. This directory published every three years by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Youngstown Foundation through the Diocesan Office of Development & Stewardship can be of help to those assisting clients with charitable intentions.

The charities in this directory meet three criteria:

- A. They are listed in *The Official Catholic Directory* published by P.J. Kenedy and Sons.
- B. They are within the geographical boundaries of the Diocese of Youngstown and/or they have personnel serving the people of the diocese.
- C. They are an operating non-profit organization providing services within the diocese and have a staff, budget, and regular source of revenue.

USING THE DIRECTORY

This directory organizes charities in 6 major sections. A client may not have a particular charity in mind, yet know he or she wants to benefit a certain type of charitable activity. By turning to a major section and reading the purposes (missions) of the charities listed, you may be able to guide the client appropriately. ALPHABETICAL LISTING OF CHARITIES

If you know the common name of the charity in which your client is interested, refer to the Index at the end of the directory. It contains an alphabetical listing of all charities published in the directory.

HOW TO READ ENTRIES

Charities are listed in the following format:

The common NAME of the charity is listed first followed by the name of a CONTACT person. The charity's ADDRESS, TELEPHONE and FAX NUMBERS are then listed. The charity's LEGAL TITLE is then stated – which may be different from the charity's common name – followed by the STATE of incorporation and its FEDERAL TAX ID number. The PURPOSE or mission of the charity is then stated, followed by a DESCRIPTION of the charity.

Parishes of the Diocese of Youngstown – The LEGAL TITLE of the parishes listed in this directory is the common name of the parish with the phrase “Catholic Church” and the parish's street address appended to it. For example, the LEGAL TITLE of the parish commonly known as St. Joseph is ...

UNRESTRICTED GIFTS

The financial needs of charities change over time. As a general rule, charities prefer unrestricted gifts for their general tax-exempt purposes. Some donors place restrictions on their charitable gifts. If restrictions ultimately become impossible to fulfill because of changing conditions, they can cause additional probate expenses to the charity to have such restrictions modified. The Diocesan Office of Development & Stewardship asks practitioners to encourage donors to consider the administrative burdens they may be inadvertently creating for a charity years from now. We ask you to encourage *unrestricted* gifts as a general rule ...

To XYZ Charity for its exempt purposes without restriction.

If XYZ Charity does not exist at the time of distribution, then to ABC charity for its exempt purposes without restriction.

RESTRICTED GIFTS

Notwithstanding the above comments about the desirability of unrestricted gifts, the philanthropic feeling of a donor may indicate a restriction on a gift. We encourage practitioners to discuss restricted gifts with the intended charity or with the Diocesan Director of Development & Stewardship before finalizing legal documents. Take time to determine if contemplated restrictions are administratively practical. Keep in mind that restrictions that are practical today may become impractical in future years. The document should anticipate this possibility and allow the charity to use the gift for another similar purpose. We recommend the following ...

To XYZ Charity (“Charity”) for {describe purpose} (“purpose”).

If Purpose does not exist at the time of distribution, Charity shall use the distribution for one or more of its exempt purposes reasonably approximate to the original Purpose. If a reasonable approximation does not exist, at the time of distribution, then to ABC Charity for its exempt purposes without restriction.

ENDOWMENTS

Practitioners are encouraged to promote endowed gifts. **Endowed gifts made to the charities listed in this Manual should be established in the Roman Catholic Diocese of Youngstown Foundation.** The Foundation is an established 501(c)(3) corporation that manages pooled assets at minimal cost and has a reporting and income disbursement process in place. TYPES OF ASSETS

Any type of property, whether real or personal, tangible or intangible, can be used for charitable giving through the methods listed in this Manual. We alert practitioners, however, that charities have varying capacities to accept and process non-cash gifts. Real estate, securities not publicly-traded and tangible personal property such as inventories or art work are types of property that can present particular challenges to the charity. We encourage practitioners to discuss these situations with the Diocesan Office of Development & Stewardship (see contact information above).

BEQUESTS

Testamentary gifts are perhaps the most common charitable gift aside from lifetime cash. We ask practitioners to please encourage clients to remember a charity in their plans by simply asking them, “Would you like to make a charitable gift?”

LIFE INCOME GIFTS

Life Income Gifts are made by an irrevocable transfer of cash, securities, bonds, or real estate, which are deposited into a specific life income program. Income from the program is paid out to the donor and/or a named beneficiary. Under life income plans, upon the death of the donor and/or other beneficiary, the assets will be used for the general or designated purposes of the charity. Life Income Gifts include:

1. Gift Annuity

A Gift Annuity is a contractual agreement between a donor and a charity whereby the charity agrees to pay a fixed annual income for life to the donor in exchange for money or assets transferred to the charity. The transaction is both the purchase of an annuity and a charitable contribution.

The Catholic Diocese of Youngstown offers a Gift Annuity Program at no cost to donors. The minimum amount accepted for a Gift Annuity is \$5,000. A sample Gift Annuity Agreement and Gift Annuity Proposals are available by contacting:

2. Deferred Gift Annuity

A Deferred Gift Annuity represents an excellent retirement plan for most donors as it makes it possible for the donor to receive an immediate income tax deduction yet defer the receipt of income for a term of years.

The donor determines the starting year of the annuity payments. The deferred gift annuity can have the advantages of a tax shelter, because the donor receives a current deduction in high-income earning years yet defers income until the time when the donor may essentially be in a lower income tax bracket. Again, practitioners are encouraged to contact Mr. Pat Palombo at the listing above for information regarding a Gift Annuity.

3. Charitable Remainder Annuity Trust

A Charitable Remainder Annuity Trust is created when a donor irrevocably transfers cash, securities, bonds, real estate or other property to an individually established, invested and managed trust. The trust stipulates that the donor and/or designated beneficiary(ies) will receive a fixed dollar amount payable at least annually, for life or for a term of years up to 20 years. At the death of the donor, or the last income beneficiary, the trust terminates and the value of the trust assets are transferred to the charity. The charitable deduction is dependent upon the age of the beneficiary, the trust's payout percentage, the fair market value of the gift assets and federal rates at the time of the gift. The trust payout is set at the time the annuity trust is established and remains fixed for the term of the agreement.

4. Charitable Remainder Unitrust

A Charitable Remainder Unitrust is established when the donor transfers assets to an individually invested, managed and administered trust. The donor retains a percentage of the trust, revalued annually, for as long as the donor and/or a survivor beneficiary lives or for a fixed term of up to 20 years. Because the trust is established with a charitable remainder beneficiary, the donor becomes eligible for substantial tax benefits. There are three basic types of Charitable Remainder Unitrust. The first type is referred to as a Standard Unitrust. In this type of trust the donor receives a percentage of the trust assets as valued annually. The second trust type is referred to as an Income Only Unitrust. Under this type of trust agreement the donor receives a fixed percentage of the trust assets as valued annually, or the actual income if less. The third trust type is called Income Only Unitrust with Makeup. Under this arrangement the donor receives the lesser of income generated by the trust or a fixed percentage payout. However, as a result of a lack of sufficient income during previous years of the trust the donor is allowed to receive increased income to the extent that it "makes up for prior year deficits."

5. Charitable Remainder Lead Trust

A Charitable Remainder Lead Trust is established when the donor transfers cash securities, bonds, real estate or other property to an individually invested, managed and administered trust. During the term of the trust it pays a fixed amount (if it is an annuity lead trust) or a percentage of the trust revalued annually (if it is a lead unitrust) to the charity. When the trust term ends, its remaining principal passes to the donor's family or heirs named in the trust. Trust growth passes to them tax free. The donor receives an income tax deduction at the time the trust is funded.

6. Gifts of Personal Residence or Farm

A personal residence or farm may be deeded to a charity with the donor retaining a life estate, that is, the right to continue to live in the home or on the farm during the donor's lifetime. When a life estate is retained by the donor, the donor is entitled to a charitable income tax deduction and his/her total estate is reduced in value which in-turn reduces possible estate taxes. The agreement can further stipulate that the spouse may live there for his/her lifetime.

The property does not have to be the donor's primary residence. It can be a vacation or second home. Furthermore, the donor does not have to reside on the property. The donor can also give stock in a co-operative apartment that is used as a residence.

7. Gifts of Life Insurance

A Gift of Life Insurance for the benefit of a charity may take many forms. A donor may give an existing paid-up policy by changing the owner and the beneficiary to the charity. A donor may give a policy on which the donor is still paying premiums and name the charity as irrevocable owner and beneficiary. A donor may name the charity as a second beneficiary sharing the proceeds with another co-beneficiary. A donor may name the charity as a second beneficiary and the proceeds will become a charitable gift if the first beneficiary has died.
